TOPIC: COUNCIL MEMBERS- ELECTION AND TERM OF OFFICE

ELECTION

Election of the Council from the membership shall be held concurrently with the Annual General Meeting of the College. At each AGM, the membership shall elect two Council members. Only those members on the Active Practicing or Inactive Register who are in good standing with the College at the date of the election are eligible for election or appointment to any position within the College.

Council appointments take effect as of the date of the Annual General Meeting. At the first meeting of the new Council, the first order of business is to elect a Chairperson and Vice-Chair or Co-Chairs of the Council. All remaining Council positions are decided by mutual consent following the first order of business.

TERM OF OFFICE

Council appointments are for a three year term.

Council members are eligible for re-election or re-appointment for 2 consecutive terms (i.e. a maximum of 6 consecutive years).

A member may not be re-elected to the Council, after having served two consecutive terms, for a period of two years.
