TOPIC: APPROVAL OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS/EDUCATION FACILITY

For the purposes of Part II of the Regulations, the Council considers the applicant's program of physiotherapy studies to be approved if:

1. The candidate graduated from the University of Manitoba's physiotherapy program.

or

2. The candidate graduated from a university physiotherapy program elsewhere in Canada that has received recent approval or accreditation from the Accreditation Council for Canadian Physiotherapy Academic Programs (ACCPAC) or the Council for Accreditation of Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE).

or

3. The candidate is eligible to sit the Physiotherapy Competency Examination (PCE) on the basis of the examination credentialling process.

The Council will direct the Board of Assessors to review the ACCPAC and PCE credentialling process and make recommendations to the Council on appropriate policy changes.
