3.19 Professional Liability Insurance Coverage

Policy:

New applicants and registrants who will be working with the public and who are applying for renewal of registration must submit proof of liability (malpractice) insurance coverage. The minimum amount of coverage required is five million dollars. The amount of coverage required will be reviewed by the Council annually.

Procedure:

1. The Registrar will accept the following as proof of coverage:
 - a letter from the employer or insurance provider
 - a letter from a health authority confirming coverage, or
 - a letter from an insurance provider confirming coverage
 - confirmation from CPA or other insurance provider of proof of purchase of malpractice insurance premium, or
 - telephone or fax confirmation from CPA other insurance provider re: malpractice insurance
2. Membership will not be renewed January 30 without proof of liability (malpractice) insurance coverage.
