3.2 Registration on the Student Roster

Policy:

The College of Physiotherapists of Manitoba (CPM) requires all physiotherapy students who are undertaking supervised fieldwork placements in Manitoba to be registered with CPM on the Student Register. This policy includes University of Manitoba students, students from other Canadian University programs in physiotherapy and international physiotherapy students.

Procedure:

1. Applicants for student registration must submit:
 - a) The application form, completed and signed
 - b) The student registration fee
 - c) Proof of enrolment in a recognized physiotherapy education program.
 - The University of Manitoba provides CPM with a class list of all students enrolled in the physiotherapy program on a yearly basis.
 - Other Canadian University physiotherapy programs will need to submit written confirmation that the applicant is a student in their program who has successfully completed all academic and clinical work to date.
 - International students will be required to provide a letter from their university to confirm successful completion of all physiotherapy academic and clinical work to date. The process for an international student is more complex and information can be found in Policy 3.7.
 - d) A current Criminal Record Check including Vulnerable Sector screen. CPM will only accept a criminal record check that is less than 6 months old.
2. Student application forms and information can be found on the CPM website.
3. Once the application form and payment is received, the student registrant will receive a copy of the CPM Reference Guide on a memory stick. University of Manitoba students will receive newsletters and other mailings throughout the year.
