3.5 Registration of International Physiotherapy Candidates

Purpose:

To state the requirements for registration with the College of Physiotherapists of Manitoba (CPM) for internationally educated physiotherapists.

Policy:

The Council has determined that for both Canadian and internationally educated physiotherapists, the Physiotherapy Competency Examination (PCE), administered by the Canadian Alliance of Physiotherapy Regulators (CAPR), is the acceptable tool to determine their readiness for safe, effective and independent physiotherapy practice.

If an internationally educated physiotherapist successfully passes the Written Component (Qualifying Exam), and wishes to work in Manitoba prior to attempting the Clinical Component (Physiotherapy National Exam), they must register on the Examination Candidate Register to practice in Manitoba.

Upon successful completion of both the Written and Clinical Component of the PCE, the individual must apply for the Active Practice Register prior to commencing independent physiotherapy practice in Manitoba.
