

## **Invitation for Applications as a Practice Auditor**

The College of Physiotherapists of Manitoba is inviting interested physiotherapists to apply to become a Practice Auditor for the Continuing Competence Program of the College.

Practice Audits are one of the components of CPM's Continuing Competence Program. Practice Audits are objective and facilitate a review of the performance of a Registrant in relation to the standards and essential competencies of the profession. The Practice Audit results provide assurance to the public of the quality of care that is delivered by the physiotherapist.

### **Role of the Practice Auditor**

- Coordinates and carries out a scheduled Practice Audit or in certain circumstances a modified assessment with assigned Registrants;
- Reviews the Registrant's practice, collects relevant data using standardized College-developed tools while providing a supportive, positive and learning experience for the Registrant;
- Completes a report, describing key observations;
- Ensures that the Practice Audit is completed within the specified timeline.

### **Assignment of Practice Auditors**

The Auditor will be assigned to a Registrant based on his or her knowledge and experience in practice (where possible) and the geographical proximity to the Registrant. In some cases, travel may be required. The Auditor's time commitment to each Practice Audit process is 4½ to 5 hours (not including travel). Practice Audits may occur on weekdays or weekends, days or evenings.

### **Qualifications**

- Eligibility for registration on the active register with CPM
- A minimum of five years clinical experience
- Agree to undergo and successfully complete a Practice Audit
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Never had an Inquiry Committee finding against them
- Willingness to travel, as required
- Have a degree of flexibility with their work schedule
- Must be able to complete reports using a computer
- Be able to commit to a two-year renewable appointment.

### **Applying to Become a Practice Auditor**

Prospective Practice Auditors are requested to submit the following documentation no later than **September 30, 2018**:

1. Cover letter explaining your interest in becoming a Practice Auditor
2. Curriculum Vitae/Résumé
