prescription safety eyewear program



Through the Manitoba Association of Optometrists' Occupational Vision Care (OVC) program, Members of the College of Physiotherapists of Manitoba (CPM) can purchase prescription safety eyewear at a fraction of normal pricing (usually 1/4–1/3 of regular cost).

Prescription safety glasses are sold according to the frame, lens and professional fees pricing agreed to with CPM.

COVID-19 protocols are in place and booked appointments are required. Advise the staff you are with CPM and coming in for prescription safety eyewear. Take your current valid CPM Registration Certificate and your current vision prescription to any of our 57 locations throughout Manitoba. If you need a new eye exam, our optometrists would be happy to provide one (fees vary).

Pay at the optometrist's office. The optometrist's office will issue a receipt so you can submit a claim through any insurance coverage you may have.

Direct billing: Participating optometrists each have their own office policies. Ask the office you are visiting if they offer direct billing and can confirm your coverage.
